David Keith has starred in over 80 movies and 100 roles, but his greatest role to date is a warrior for child protection. David's trademark take-no-prisoner style, and laser focus on fighting child predators, epitomizes PROTECT's stance as a pro-child, anti-crime grassroots lobby. He quickly became one of PROTECT's most dynamic and effective leaders. After working as Campaign Chairman, in 2008 he turned his focus to development and long-term growth, both for PROTECT and Promise to Protect.

David first teamed up with PROTECT in 2004 to successfully reform Tennessee law on the introduction of evidence in child abuse cases. Never simply a "celebrity spokesperson," David is well known on Capitol Hill and in state legislatures from Nashville to Sacramento. He led the way to passage for several Tennessee laws, including the Full Disclosure in Court Law, the Baby Haley Law and the War on Child Predators TN Bill and "Minutes Count" legislation. He helped pass the landmark 2005 California Circle of Trust Bill; a victory which repealed California's incest loophole. Mr. Keith also led the charge in CA, TN and VA for passage of Alicia's Law to rescue children from child pornographers and provide resources to law enforcement task forces. Recently, David was the driving force behind the conception and success of the 2008 Protect Our Children Act, the largest and most high profile crime bill in the 110th Congress.
